

all United States armed forces are withdrawn by December 31, 1970; and
4. To refuse to appropriate funds for any expansion of the Vietnam war or for its continuation beyond December 31, 1970.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the members of the Virginia delegation in the Congress and the President of the United States.

#3--BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Fairfax County Democratic Committee is directed to send a letter to Larry O'Brien urging him to call a conference of Democratic leaders over Memorial Day weekend to discuss the war in Indochina.

#4--BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Fairfax County Democratic Committee is directed to invite Dr. Hoofnagle to speak at the next Committee meeting.

#5--WHEREAS it appears that the National Democratic Party is in substantial debt from previous campaigns; and
WHEREAS the debt of the National Democratic Committee may affect the credit and good name of the National Democratic Party; and
WHEREAS the credit and good name of the Democratic Party is a matter with which all democrats should be concerned;
THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Fairfax County Democratic Committee hereby pledges to pay ten dollars (\$10.00) a month to the National Democratic Committee for the reduction of the National Committee's debt and for the support and maintenance of the National Democratic Committee and the principles for which it stands.

#6 --BE IT RLSOLVED that the Fairfax County Democratic Committee hereby changes the date of the July 1970 meeting to September 1, 1970.

#7 --BE IT RESOLVED, in accordance with the platform adopted by the Fairfax County Democratic Convention, that the Fairfax County Democratic Committee requests that the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors withhold the issuance of further building permits and sewage connections in the Occoquan Drainage Area at this time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fairfax County Democratic Committee urges the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors to initiate a request to the State Water Control Board for a moratorium on all further sewage connections in the Occoquan Basin until a program is outlined which will improve the water quality, maintain water quantity and determine the effect of siltation on the water supply.
