

RESOLUTION

\$ 1,000,000,000.⁰⁰

Be it further resolved that the Democratic nominees for the office of Supervisor of each Service District shall be selected by the method determined by the Democratic Committee of that District subject to the approval of the FCDC steering committee at the meeting on March 8; and

Be it further resolved that the steering committee on that date will also determine the method of selection of the Democratic nominee for Chairman of the Board.
