

RESOLUTIONS

The following resolutions were passed unanimously by the Fairfax County Democratic Committee at the meeting on Tuesday, January 17, 1984.

The Fairfax County Democratic Committee sends its best wishes to the Northern Virginia Delegation, led by Senator Clive DuVal, for a successful session of the Virginia General Assembly. Furthermore, we use this occasion to express our great confidence in the ability of the delegation to provide outstanding representation for the citizens of the area.

Whereas, as stated in the Preamble of its Party Plan, the Virginia Democratic Party exists to facilitate and encourage the full participation of Virginians in choosing their elected officials and controlling their political destiny; and,

Whereas, full participation begins with the registration of eligible Virginia voters but the percentage of registered voters in the Commonwealth is among the lowest in the nation; and,

Whereas, Governor Charles S. Robb has appointed a Commission to Increase Voter Registration in the Commonwealth and in his 1984 State of the Commonwealth message stated his support for removing laws prohibiting registrars from active participation in voter registration activities;

Be it therefore resolved that the Fairfax County Democratic Committee asks the Committees on Privileges and Elections in the House of Delegates and the Senate of Virginia to favorably consider bills brought before them which seek to responsibly encourage the registration of eligible voters and make it easier for registrars to register voters in the Commonwealth; and,

Be it further resolved that the Corresponding Secretary is directed to prepare copies of this resolution for transmittal to the Chairmen of the Committees on Privileges and Elections in the House of Delegates and Senate of Virginia.
