### RESOLUTION RE: ACTIONS OF DEMOCRATIC PUBLIC OFFICIALS

Whereas, the Democratic Party is a public instrument of government,

Whereas, the Democratic Party seeks support and votes for its policies and programs from the public of which the majority are women,

Whereas, the Democratic Party depends on the volunteer and paid work of women,

Whereas, recent public events attended by Democratic officials and officeholders excluded and demeaned women,

Therefore, be it resolved that officials and officeholders of the Democratic Party in Virginia should adhere to a standard of conduct in public events that respects and values women and which necessarily prohibits public participation in events or activities that demean either sex and specifically demean women by their use as sex objects as entertainment and use of derogatory comments and that women and men political workers and party officials be alert to any campaign or party practices that in any way demean either sex in political activities.

THIS RESOLUTION, UPON ADOPTION BY THE FAIRFAX COUNTY DEMOCRATIC COMMITTEE, WILL BE SENT TO THE VIRGINIA STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE FOR ITS ADOPTION.
