

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS in his last Federal Budget President Reagan proposed suspending cost of living adjustments of the retirement incomes of Federal employees and military personnel, and

WHEREAS the conditions of employment for Federal workers and military personnel have included the protection of retirement benefits from erosion from inflation through the process of cost of living adjustments, and

WHEREAS arbitrary denial of such adjustments is a callous breaking of agreements long held secure, and

WHEREAS this proposal will have a highly negative impact on already low morale in the Federal work force which sorely needs improvement, and

WHEREAS the Fairfax County Democratic Committee favors positive steps to balance the Federal Budget, but deplores using special classes of people to do so,

THEREFORE the FCDC urges the Congress to reject this ill-conceived notion and continue the present provisions of the law.
