RESOLUTION

RESOLVED, that the Fairfax County Democratic Committee adopts the following Reorganization Plan for the 1990-91 biennium:

APPORTIONMENT

- 1) The apportionment of the Fairfax County Democratic Committee shall comprise:
 - a) No less than two members per precinct;
 - b) Five members at-large from each magisterial district;
 - c) A proportional allocation of members per precinct from a converging calculation based on the quotient of the average votes cast for the Democratic Candidates for Governor, Lieutenant Governor and Attorney General in the 1989 General Election divided by 530, and adjusted for the requirements in a and b above, in order to allocate 529 memberships.
- 2) No precinct for which the boundaries have not changed shall have its membership reduced from the 1988-89 biennium; this requirement shall be satisfied after the allocation indicated in c above and any additional members shall not be counted against the 530.
- 3) In each precinct, no more than the number of memberships allocated to the precinct minus one shall be filled by non-residents of that precinct.

CAUCUSES

- 1) To elect members to the Fairfax County Democratic Committee for the 1990-91 biennium, caucuses shall be held in each magisterial district on Thursday, November 30, 1989, at 8:15 p.m..
- 2) Each caucus shall be held in a public place designated by the district committee.
- 3) The district chair, or his or her designee, shall serve as the temporary chair of the district caucus.
- 4) In cases in which more persons have filed than there are seats in a precinct, the temporary chair of the district caucus shall appoint a temporary chair for the precinct caucus. The Democrats from each precinct shall then elect the members from among the persons who have filed.
- 5) The election of district officers shall proceed according to Roberts Rules of Order.

FILING FORMS AND FEES

- 1) Each person who seeks election to the Fairfax County Democratic Committee shall submit a filing form, or reasonable facsimile thereof, and a filing fee of \$40 to the district chair or his or her designee or the county chair not later than 8:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 29.
- 2) The Democratic Headquarters at 7245 Arlington Boulevard, Suite 205, Falls Church, shall remain open from its normal business hours until 8:00 p.m. on November 29 in order to receive filing forms.
- 3) The \$40 dollar filing fee may be paid in two installments; one at the time of filing, the other on or before January 1, 1991.
- 4) In cases of hardship, the filing fee may be waived, in whole or in part, by the district chair or the county chair.
- 5) In order for the election of members to be valid for the January Reorganization Meeting, all filing forms and fees must be submitted by the district chairs or his or her designee to Democratic Headquarters by 11:00 a.m., November 30, 1989.

PUBLICITY

- 1) The county chair shall cause to be published in a local newspaper, within the period established in the State Party Plan, an announcement of the caucuses, their location and information about pre-filing.
- 2) The county chair shall also publicize the caucuses and filing requirements in the Democrat, by press releases and any other appropriate means.

EX OFFICIO MEMBERS

- 1) Democratic elected officials in or from Virginia who reside in Fairfax County shall be voting ex officio members of the Fairfax County Democratic Committee upon payment of the \$40 filing fee.
- 2) Elected members of the Democratic National Committee who reside in Fairfax County shall be voting ex officio members of the Fairfax County Democratic Committee upon payment of the \$40 filing fee.
- 3) Members of the State Central Committee shall be voting ex officio members of the Fairfax County Democratic Committee upon payment of the \$40 filing fee.
