

# VOTE to turn Virginia BLUE Tue Nov 5!

State Senators & Delegates, County Supervisors & Chair, School Board, Sheriff, Commonwealth Attorney, Soil & Water Conservation  
**Make a Voting Plan: 1) Check registration 2) Vote Early 3) Forward Alerts**

**Register to Vote or Update Address** by 10/15/19, verify your polling place & voting district at: [FairfaxDemocrats.org/voting](http://FairfaxDemocrats.org/voting)

**Vote Early: Protect your vote** against bad weather or traffic, getting busy or sick. **Just show up** at any Vote Early site (right column) and **select a code** to qualify to vote early (“in-person absentee”), such as:

- 1. Work or Personal Business:** On Election Day, you might leave your city/county of residence *for any amount of time* because of:  
**Code 1C** – Work, job, business  
**Code 1D** – Any personal reason (trip or visit, meeting, appointment, vacation, class, errand)  
**Code 1E** – 11-hr combined work-commute inside county: use *only* if Code **1C** doesn’t apply
- 2. College/Military/First Responder:**  
**Code 1A/1B** – You or your spouse attend college outside your city/county of residence  
**Code 6A/6B** – You, or spouse/dependent at home are active duty military/merchant marine  
**Code 1F** – You are a first responder
- 3. Health Issues or Caregiver:**  
**Code 2A** – Disabled, ill, difficulty waiting in line  
**Code 2B** – Main caregiver for disabled at home  
**Code 2C** – You are pregnant

**Bring Photo ID, need no other voter card.** Valid Virginia driver’s license (old address OK), US passport, any ID issued by USG or any VA govt entity, VA student ID, etc. (more below).
